d. Every athlete must record a video 

1. according to the registered category (Jurus Tunggal / Beregu)
2. accordance with the recording procedure
3. accordance with Video Submission Procedures

e. The procedure for video recording 

1. videos can be recorded indoors or outdoors
2. Make sure video lighting
3. The athlete's position must always be in frame the video
4. The camera must always stay centered, use a tripod 
5. adjust the distance between the camera and the athlete, so that all movements can be recorded perfectly
6. Video recording must be done when the athlete is in a position facing the camera from the initial position
7. the minimum video resolution is 720p
8. video sent without editing

f. Video Submission Procedure

1. Each athlete sends 1 video, in each category Tunggal / Beregu
2. Register and send video with link google form Indonesia Open, https://bit.ly/INDONESIA_OPEN

g. System and stages

TO : Senior Category - 17 years old above up 35 years old
Junior Category - 14 years old up to 17 years old

1. The match is made with a pool system consisting of 4 participants and the best video 1,2,3, will get a prize

TO : Pre-junior category - 12 years old up to 14 years old
Pre-Teen Category - 10 years old up to 12 years old
Early Category - 7 years old up to 9 years old

1. The match is made with a pool system consisting of 4 participants and the best video 1,2,3, will get a prize

6. scoring system

- a. Rating based on Video received Resolution of at least 720p
- b. All participants' performances were judged by judges assigned by PERSILAT
- c. Assessment uses a digital scoring system by Eventsilat.com


